



## Cleaning /Flood Bucket Contents – Value \$65

### Purpose

Cleaning/flood buckets contain the basic cleaning supplies needed when beginning the process of cleaning homes after natural disaster or human-induced calamity.

### Contents

- One 5-gallon bucket with re-sealable lid  
New buckets are preferred and can be purchased at Lowes, Home Depot, Ace Hardware, etc. Used buckets from food service or restaurants are permissible if properly washed. Buckets which have stored chemicals, paint, pool chemicals, etc., are not permissible.
- 5 scouring pads. Remove from packaging. No stainless steel, no Brillo or SOS pads-no soap built in.
- 7 sponges (dry only) Remove from packaging. No cellulose sponges due to mold issues.
- 18 cleaning wipes (reusable, non-linen); Handi-wipes types; no terry cleaning towels.
- Liquid laundry detergent 50 oz. (2-25 oz. or 1-50 oz.)
- 1 household cleaner, 12-16 oz. plastic bottle
- 1 disinfectant dish soap, 16-28 oz. plastic bottle
- 50 clothes pins
- Clothes line (two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.) Cotton or plastic
- 5 dust masks
- 2 pair heavy-duty reusable latex gloves
- 1 pair leather palm work gloves; cotton with leather palm or totally leather
- 24-bag roll of heavy-duty trash bags, 33-45 gallon size. Remove roll from box.
- 1 insect repellent spray, 6-14 oz. plastic bottle w/protective cap
- Air freshener, 8 or 9 oz. bottle w/protective cap

### Assembly

Place all liquid items in the bucket first. Place remaining items in the bucket fitting them around and between the liquid items. Sponges, scouring pads, clothespins and trash bags can be separated in order to fit all of the items in the bucket. Ensure the lid is closed securely.

### Notes:

- All items must be new except for the bucket and lid.
- All cleaning agents must be liquid and in plastic containers.
- No powders, please.

- If you cannot find the requested size of a liquid item, use a smaller size. Including larger sizes of any item will prevent the lid from sealing.

We must know what you will be bringing so that we can coordinate your arrival, be prepared to let us know the exact day and time of arrival so that we can have staff available.
- We can accommodate mid-size U-Haul or Ryder type box trucks, pickup trucks, flat bed and enclosed trailers, or cars for deliveries. Tractor-trailers are also okay; a loading dock, fork truck and pallet jacks are on site. Volunteers should accompany the delivery of the relief kits and be prepared to help unload once arriving at the MNA Warehouse.
- Volunteer waivers are needed for each individual visiting the warehouse or depot . You can print and sign these in advance of your arrival: [Click here to download](#)
- If you anticipate the need for overnight accommodations while you are making a delivery at the **Rome Warehouse** please notify us in advance; we may be able to arrange lodging. Please know that housing may be limited and a morning delivery will work best so you can get back out the same day if at all possible, especially in times of new disaster responses and there is elevated activity at the warehouse or depot.
