Collection and Delivery Instructions

- Items should be delivered in person or shipped to the MNA Warehouse in Rome GA.
- Notify us in advance of your collection campaign as needs change daily.
- Once your collection efforts are complete and before departure for the MNA Warehouse, please prepare an abstract list of your collection and send to us electronically at mnawarehouse@pcanet.org so that we know what you will be bringing and that we can coordinate your arrival. This is important so that we can plan accordingly. Be prepared to let us know the exact day and time of arrival so that we can coordinate delivery.
- Mid-size U-Haul or Rider trucks, pickup trucks, and enclosed trailers work best for deliveries. Tractor Trailers are also okay; a loading dock is on site.
- Volunteers should accompany the delivery of the equipment and supplies to help unload once arriving at the MNA Warehouse.
- If you anticipate needed overnight accommodations while you are making a delivery at the MNA Warehouse please notify us in advance; we may be able to arrange lodging. Please know that housing may be limited and a morning delivery may work best so you can get back out the same day if at all possible, especially in times of new disaster responses.
