MNA DISASTER RESPONSE WAREHOUSE





The MNA Charles H. Jones Family Disaster Response Center supports the relief efforts of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA) by marshaling critically-needed resources, supplied by God's people, to communities in critical need due to disasters. The 15,000 square foot facility, located on 1.5 acres in Rome Georgia, includes a warehouse, training center, repair facility, and a fenced parking area for the ministry's rolling stock of trucks and trailers.

All items contained within the warehouse and the warehouse itself have either been donated directly or purchased with donated funds.



Deployment

The warehouse stocks three main categories of relief items. All items are deployed at no cost to those who need them.



RELIEF SUPPLIES

Consumable supplies such as flood buckets, hygiene kits, school supply kits, and more are stocked in the warehouse for immediate deployment wherever needed.



EQUIPMENT

Chainsaws, water pumps, generators, and hand and power tools of all types are available for deployment to disaster sites.



ROLLING STOCK

Bunkhouses, showers, transport trailers, track loaders, trailer-mounted generators, and fuel trailers are available to deploy to disaster sites as needed.
