In 2015, MNA Disaster Response called Mike Kenamer to serve as Regional Specialist in the Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia (TAG) Region where he coordinates responses within the region, develops resources, and trains, coaches, and encourages individuals and churches to engage in disaster response.

Mike took on additional responsibilities in 2018 when he was asked to manage the MNA Disaster Response Warehouse in Rome, Georgia. In this role he developed, monitors, and maintains the inventory system, assuring that tools and relief supplies are ready for deployment to disaster sites across the U.S. and Canada. Mike also serves as the lead trainer for MNA Disaster Response and regularly schedules training at the Charles H. Jones Family Disaster Response Center and at churches across the U.S.

2022 Summary*

We were blessed in 2022 to be able to serve in the following ways:

- Responded to and/or assisted with disasters in:
 - Wears Valley, TN (wildfires - built Sheds of Hope)
 - Bowling Green, KY (floods - consulted with and offered assistance)
 - Neon, KY (floods - taught track loader and Sheds of Hope training as well as organized a work team from our church)
 - Florida (Hurricane Ida - sent equipment and supplies to equip the teams in Sarasota, Port Orange, and Naples)
- Coordinated eleven warehouse work days
- Hosted three warehouse work teams
- Shared the ministry with 15 churches
- Taught nine training sessions
- Upgraded and maintained TAG Region Response trailer
- Upgraded Sheds of Hope Deployment trailer
- And more...

2023 GOALS

Share

- Establish new relationships with 15 churches
- Share ministry with 100 people

- Grow the warehouse audience to 400

Prepare

- Coordinate 11 warehouse work days
- Upgrade warehouse inventory system
- Host 4 warehouse work teams

Train

- Teach 6 training sessions
- Attend at least one training session for professional growth

Fund

- Raise \$48,000 for the annual fund

Respond

- At the request of local churches, respond to all disasters in the region
- Assist in responses outside the region
- Deploy equipment and supplies to disasters throughout North America



2023 Budget Needs

Each MNA ministry must raise the funds necessary to operate the ministry. For 2023, \$48,000 in annual fund giving is needed to support the work of the TAG Region and Warehouse Manager.

- \$36,000 for personnel expenses (ongoing expense), including salary and healthcare
